

Annual Environmental Awareness and Sustainability Activities

In compliance with the guidelines of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) regarding Environmental Education and co-scholastic development, Vivekananda World School, Ferozpur, implements structured environmental awareness and sustainability activities as part of its annual school programme.

As a key initiative, World Environment Day 2025 was observed in collaboration with the Department of Forests and Wildlife Conservation to promote environmental responsibility among students. The programme included a planned tree plantation drive within the school premises, emphasizing the importance of ecological balance, biodiversity conservation, and sustainable living.



The event was conducted in the presence of the Chief Guest, Ms. Anuradha (Civil Judge-cum-Secretary, District Legal Services Authority), along with Special Guests Mr. Satinder Singh, Divisional Forest Officer, and Mr. Gurjit Singh, Range Officer. The dignitaries were joined by representatives from the school management and supporting organisations, including Smt. Prabha Bhaskar, Mr. Rahul Mittal (Bhagwati Lacto Pvt. Ltd.), Dr. S. N. Rudra, Ms. Dolly Bhaskar, and Mrs. Navita Singhal, whose participation strengthened the collaborative approach towards environmental conservation.



Students actively participated in plantation activities and undertook a pledge to protect and nurture the saplings. Symbolic activities, such as tying rakhis to plants, were conducted to reinforce the values of care, responsibility, and long-term commitment towards nature. The programme also included student-led cultural presentations comprising welcome songs, group singing, and poetry recitations with themes centred on environmental protection and sustainability.

The initiative was further reinforced through the active involvement of the NCC cadets of Vivekananda World School. Under the guidance of CTO Ms. Sukhjinder Kaur, NCC cadets carried out a tree plantation drive and participated in awareness sessions highlighting the role of trees in air purification, pollution control, and ecosystem preservation. Emphasis was laid on the importance of regular monitoring and maintenance of the planted saplings.
