The Parent-Teacher Association of Vivekananda World School functions as a statutory body to ensure effective participation of parents in the academic and overall development of students. Annual PTA discussions are conducted as per CBSE norms to promote coordination between parents, teachers and the school management.

The PTA committee is constituted for a tenure of one academic year. The structure, roles and responsibilities of the committee members are discussed, along with the requirement of quorum for the validity of meetings and decision-making. To maintain transparency, the list of PTA executive members is displayed on the school notice board.

Academic matters form a significant part of PTA discussions. These include implementation of the prescribed curriculum, teaching-learning processes, assessment and examination patterns, academic planning, and monitoring of student progress. Measures for academic support, remedial instruction, and enrichment activities are also discussed to address diverse learning needs.

Co-curricular and extracurricular activities are included in PTA discussions to ensure holistic development of students. Planning and participation in sports, cultural activities, literary programmes, value education, life skills, and personality development initiatives are reviewed.

The role and importance of Parent-Teacher Meetings are discussed to strengthen regular communication between parents and teachers. Parents are informed about their wards' academic performance, behaviour, attendance, learning habits, strengths, and areas requiring improvement. Guidance is also provided to parents regarding academic support at home and adherence to school rules and policies. The objective of PTMs is to work collaboratively for the holistic development of students.

Student welfare is an integral part of PTA discussions. Issues related to student safety, discipline, health, hygiene, counselling support, attendance, punctuality, and emotional well-being are addressed to ensure a safe and supportive school environment.

Infrastructure and resources required for effective teaching and learning are also discussed. These include classrooms, laboratories, library facilities, digital resources, sanitation, and safety measures as per prescribed norms.

Parents are provided an opportunity to share suggestions and feedback during PTA discussions. Constructive inputs are considered for continuous improvement in academic processes, student welfare, and school functioning. Resolutions and action points are framed based on discussions, and follow-up mechanisms are planned for effective implementation.

Through these structured annual PTA discussions, Vivekananda World School ensures compliance with CBSE guidelines and promotes a collaborative approach towards academic excellence and holistic development of students.
